CLASS TIMES:

Please note that children will be welcomed in the Preschool Door *5 minutes* before class begins: Afternoon Class times are: 12:00pm – 2:00pm

*Please observe and respect program times, as we have other programs beginning right after class! Thank You.

ARRIVALS & DEPARTURES:

Our parking lot is a VERY busy place.

REMEMBER TO ALWAYS HOLD YOUR CHILD'S HAND IN OUR PARKING LOT!

When arriving, PLEASE PULL ALL THE WAY FORWARD into the parking spaces provided to avoid congestion in our crowded parking lot. The parking spaces are for YOUR USE and not for staff. We ask that you escort your child to our side Preschool Entrance, in a safe manner, where you will be greeted by our Preschool Team, five minutes before class begins. Once all the children have arrived, your child's teachers assist the children with getting ready to enter the classroom.

Prompt pick up is important to your child and greatly appreciated by their teachers. A late fee of \$5/dollars for the first minute and then \$1/minute for every minute after will be charged for all late pickups. At the end of each preschool class, we will be outside enjoying some outdoor activities and learning. Please make your departure prompt so that others can come into the parking lot to pick up as well. Please let us know if someone different will be picking up your child each day. If there are any changes to your child's regular "going home" routine, our staff must be advised in advance. Staff will not release your child to anyone without your authorization.

REMINDERS:

- We prefer payment by e-transfer, please send to our auto deposit: <u>leighanne@ladybuglanding.ca</u> If you do not have access to e-transfer, we will accept a CHEQUE. Please date for the first of month. There will be a \$10/day late fee for payments made after the 5th.
- Every day please bring a backpack for your child with a pair of clean indoor shoes (easily manageable by your child), as well as a <u>COMPLETE</u> change of clothing, these items <u>need</u> to be clearly labelled with your child's first name and last initial.
- BOOTS & RAIN GEAR for our rainy days we **do** go outside in the rain.
- A labelled water bottle.
- Appropriate clothing for the weather
- Remember to please <u>label everything</u> (Winter clothes as well).

Belongings <u>MUST BE LABELLED</u> to eliminate mistaken sharing of items or lost items.

THEME:

Our theme this month is Ladybugs!

HEALTH POLICY:

Although we encourage regular attendance at preschool, children with signs of illness should NOT come to school. It is safer for one child to stay at home for a few days than to expose the whole group to an illness. If we have sick children attending in all of our classes, weekly, the staff are constantly exposed and inevitably will end up sick, threatening temporary closures of our program. If you are unsure whether to bring your child, please call and ask for assistance.

"When in doubt, keep them out!"

Children must be symptom free for 24 hours before returning to Preschool.

BIRTHDAYS:

At Ladybug, we believe that birthdays are important no matter how old you are! We will be celebrating each child's birthday with a "Birthday Card and Book" and by singing "Happy Birthday". If you wish to bring in a store-bought treat to share in celebration of your child's Birthday, please speak with the teachers in advance. Please let us know if your family does not wish to participate in these festivities and we will respect that choice.
